BYELAW 29 REMINDER

THIS CAME INTO AFFECT ON THE 11TH JUNE 2009

River Exe – Prohibition of Netting (9th January 2009)

Notwithstanding Byelaws No 12 & 17. No net shall be used for taking fish in any tidal waters enclosed by a line drawn 068° true from Langstone Point to Orcombe Point at the entrance to the River Exe, Devon.

Provided that this Byelaw shall not prohibit the use of :-

- a) fyke nets for taking eels (*Anguilla Anguilla*), licensed by the Environment Agency.
- b) seine nets for taking salmon and sea trout licensed by the Environment Agency.
- c) landing nets used in conjunction with rod and line.
- d) seine nets with a mesh no greater than 20mm and no greater than 20 meters in total length and with a draft not exceeding 3 meters for the taking of sandeels (*Ammodytes marinus*)
